Planning Poker


ds, each card


has a valid estimate (Fibonacci series) written on it

- Customer/Product owner reads a story and it's discussed briefly
- Each estimator selects a cart that's his or her estimate
- Cards are turned over so all can see them
- Discuss differences (especially outliers)
- Re-estimate until estimates converge
